

SOMERSET COUNTY COVID-19 VACCINATION PROGRAM



WHEN WILL THE VACCINES BE AVAILABLE?



Vaccine distribution started mid-December. Somerset County's Department of Health is committed to supporting the state's goal of vaccinating 70 percent or more of its adult population against the COVID-19 virus by Labor Day.



WHERE WILL SOMERSET COUNTY VACCINATION SITES BE?



Raritan Valley Community College will be the main vaccination site, with other convenient locations throughout the county announced as more vaccine is delivered, starting in early January.



WHO WILL RECEIVE THE FIRST VACCINATIONS?



All vaccinations will require advanced registration. During Phase 1, critical populations defined by the CDC will be the first groups offered the COVID-19 vaccine. These defined groups include:

GROUP 1A

Community Health Care Providers



GROUP 1B

Essential Employees



GROUP 1C

High Risk General Population



Once the vaccine becomes more widely available, doses will be distributed to the general population.

Every Somerset County resident who wishes to be vaccinated against Covid-19 will be able to do so by Labor Day, with most doing so significantly sooner.
