Where – Municipal Field

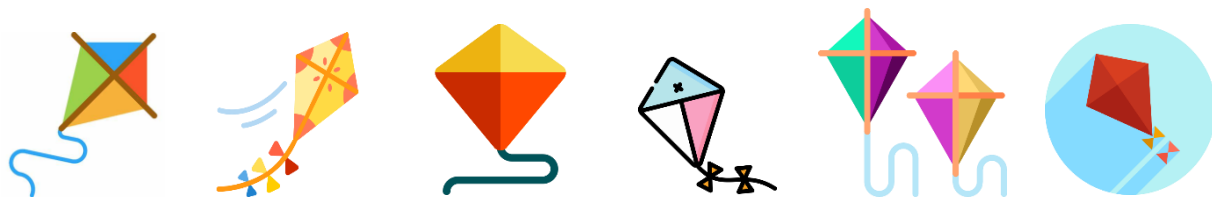
When – Monday, February 8, 2021 @ 3:30PM – 4:30PM

FANTASTIC KITE FACTS

- ❖ **The longest kite** - measured a whopping 3,394 feet.
- ❖ **The fastest kite** - A kite was recorded flying at a speed of 120 mph.
- ❖ **The longest kite trip** - A kite once flew for 180 hours straight
- ❖ **The most kites** - A Japanese kite-maker flew 11,284 kites on a single line — the largest number recorded
- ❖ **Kites are scientific** – teach you about wind pressure, thrust, and drag! And used over the centuries in scientific experiments – Ben Franklin used one to demo the electrical nature of lightning.
