**ORDINANCE NO. 1079-2019**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER IX, "PERSONNEL POLICIES," OF THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF PEAPACK AND GLADSTONE, COUNTY OF SOMERSET, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

WHEREAS, the Borough previously codified its personnel policies into Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, the governing body finds that adopting personnel policies via resolution is more efficient and enables the Borough to operate efficiently and smoothly; and

WHEREAS, the governing body wishes to repeal the Borough Code section concerning personnel policies and intends to adopt its personal policies by resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the Borough of Peapack and Gladstone as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter IX, "Personnel Policies," of the Borough Code is hereby repealed in its entirety. The Mayor, Administrator, and such other Borough officials as may be required, are hereby authorized to take such actions as may be necessary to effectuate the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION TWO: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. The Clerk of the Borough is authorized to renumber and/or re-codify any sections affected by such repeal to the extent consistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION THREE: If any word, phrase, clause, sections, or provision of this Ordinance shall be found by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal, or unconstitutional, such word, phrase, clause, section, or provision shall be severable from the balance of the Ordinance and the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication thereof after final passage according to law.
